**Why separate waste:** due to the preservation of nature and the environment.

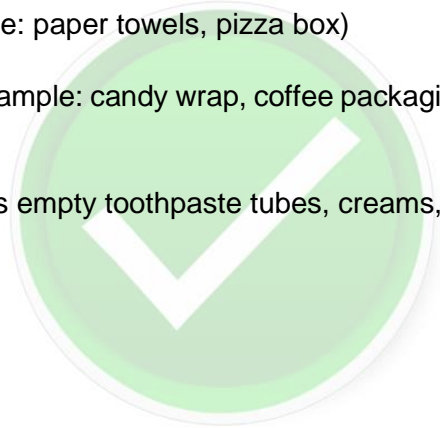
<b>In the yellow container for plastic and metal packaging, WE PUT</b>	<b>In the yellow container for plastic and metal packaging, WE DON'T PUT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tetrapak packaging</li> <li>Packaging of detergents, shampoos</li> <li>Cans</li> <li>Metal and plastic lids and caps, aluminum foil</li> <li>Plastic bags, bubble wrap, plastic foil...</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kid's toys</li> <li>Styrofoam, sponges, laminate</li> <li>Bulky waste (various plastic pipes, various furniture, cables...)</li> <li>Pressure packs (various sprays)</li> <li>Packaging of hazardous waste such as packaging of corrosive acids and substances (pesticides, paints, varnishes, solvents) and packaging of motor oils ...</li> </ul>
<b>Important! Wash and flatten the packaging before putting it away!</b>	

<b>In the blue container for paper WE PUT</b>	<b>In the blue container for paper WE DON'T PUT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Newspaper and office paper</li> <li>Magazines, catalogs, leaflets, notebooks</li> <li>Paper and cardboard packaging (boxes for food and cosmetic products, egg boxes, shoe boxes, smaller cardboard boxes)...</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plasticized paper</li> <li>Metallized paper</li> <li>Soiled and greasy paper, wet tissues, indigo papers, photographs, wet paper (unusable for recycling)</li> <li>Self-adhesive foil</li> </ul>
<b>Important! Flatten the packaging before putting it away!</b>	

<b>In the green container for glass WE PUT</b>	<b>In the green container for glass WE DON'T PUT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Glass packaging without caps or other plastic or metal parts</li> <li>Glass bottles of all colors (wine, alcoholic beverages, juices)</li> <li>Glass cups</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Windows, medical and automotive glass</li> <li>Packaging of strong chemicals</li> <li>Light bulbs and neon lamps</li> <li>Mirrors, optical glass</li> <li>Crystal, porcelain, ceramics...</li> </ul>
<b>Important! Before putting it away, empty and wash the packaging!</b>	

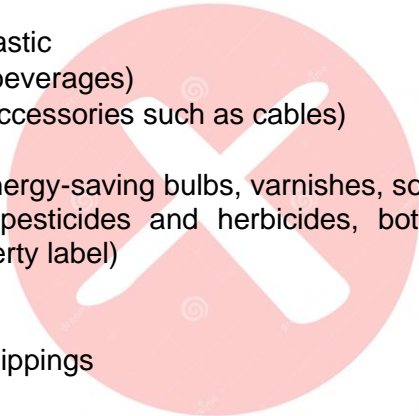
### In the container for mixed municipal waste, we put:

- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Toilet paper, wet wipes
- Soiled or coated wax paper (for example: paper towels, pizza box)
- Stickers, indigo paper, wallpaper
- Plasticized and metallized paper (for example: candy wrap, coffee packaging...)
- Photos
- Diapers, sanitary napkins, cotton wool
- Sponges, Styrofoam packaging, various empty toothpaste tubes, creams, etc.
- Porcelain, ceramics
- Light bulbs (ordinary), glasses
- Cigarettes, lighters
- Razors for shaving
- Smaller toys
- Cat litter
- Remains of thermally processed food (meat, fish, vegetables) and bones
- Other products unsuitable for recycling



### In the container for mixed municipal waste, we don't put

- Packaging made of metal, glass and plastic
- Tetrapak packaging (of milk and other beverages)
- Electrical and electronic devices (and accessories such as cables)
- Bulky, metal and construction waste
- Hazardous waste (fluorescent bulbs, energy-saving bulbs, varnishes, solvents, batteries, accumulators, residues of pesticides and herbicides, bottles of cleaning agents with a hazardous property label)
- Liquid and semi-liquid waste
- Embers and hot ash
- Soil, stones, tree branches and grass clippings
- Animal carcasses
